This flat fee covers best of show and individual entries. *Note: Late entries will not be accepted.*
- Online News Site: This best of show category is also included in the \$25 entry fee. (For stand-alone news sites, standard \$25 submission fee applies.)

### Guidelines for individual contest entries

- For individual entries, complete the online entry form at [nccma.unc.edu](http://nccma.unc.edu). Newspapers may submit no more than three individual entries per category for the calendar year. PDF tearsheets must be submitted for each individual entry. Newspapers may submit individual entries only if participating in the overall best of show. **Limit: three entries per category.**

#### Contest categories are:

- Opinion Writing (up to 3)
- Sports Writing (up to 3)
- News Writing (up to 3)
- Feature Writing (up to 3)
- Photography (up to 3)
- Single- or Two-Page Design (up to 3)
- Illustration/Graphic (up to 3)
- Cartoon (up to 3)
- Digital Storytelling (up to 3, limit to one link for each)

Results will be announced Feb. 24, 2024, during the NCCMA Conference for College Media Students and Advisers at High Point University.
